



## Futsal Tournament's Official Rules – EURO MILANO 2022

**Men:** qualification round on Friday; 1/8 final, 1/4 final, semi final and finals on Saturday. Matches will be play as knockout round

**Women:** qualification round on Friday; 1/4 final, semi final and finals on Saturday. Matches will be play as knockout round

**The team has to be close to the field in time.**

**After 5 mn of delay respect to the planned timetable, the match is judged lost for the absent team.**

**FIELD:** 2 fields outdoor synthetic grass

The rules for the EURO EUROMILANO 2022 futsal tournament are the official rules of FIGC (Federazione Italiana Giuoco Calcio), with the following exceptions:

### Rules of conduct

1. The tournament, although organized with the utmost care with the format of a competition between teams, must first of all remain an opportunity to share an experience of sport and entertainment with university students from other Countries. Therefore, unsportsmanlike conduct or contrary to fair play principles, will lead to penalties for the player and/or the team at the discretion of the organization, up to the possible exclusion from EuroMilano;
2. It is not foreseen the warm-up of the teams in the field, which must do it in spaces that may be available close to the field;
3. The schedule of matches can be changed due to exceptional organizational needs. The teams will be notified of the changes with the greatest possible notice to limit the relative discomfort.

### Match duration

All the matches will have a duration of two times of 10 minutes each (mid-time 2 minutes), running time.

Starting from 1/8 finals, if a match is even, the winner will be decided by penalties (three penalties for each team. If even again, then 1 penalty per team)

The ranking within the same group will be determined on: points, result of the direct match, goal difference, goals scored, penalties

### Time outs

Time-outs will be allowed. There will be one for each team during the entire match and only starting from semi-final round.

### Double penalties

Because of the reduced duration of matches, each foul committed by a team will be punished with a double penalty starting from the 4<sup>th</sup> team foul each half.

### Colours of the shirts

If the two teams have shirts of similar colours, at the referee's discretion, the first team as indicated in the match schedule will change their shirt, wearing the yellows/orange shirt provided by EURO MILANO Organization

### Identification of the players

The identification of the players of each team will be done by the Organizing Committee.

The teams must be on the playground at least 15 minutes before the scheduled starting time. Any case of delay over 5' from the scheduled starting time will be carefully evaluated by the Organizing Committee and the team that won't have been present at the right time could lose the match with the score of 0-3. A match cannot start if each team has not minimum three players on the ground.

### Players sent off

When a player is sent off by the referee, his team will play without a player for two minutes or until the opponents score a goal. The sent off player will not be allowed to play again in the same match, but in general will be allowed to play the next match, if heavier sanctions will not be decided against him by the Organizing Committee. Players or teams which will be held responsible of violent acts against other players or referees could be excluded immediately from the Tournament.

**Also:** The Organizing Committee could make some changes based on the organizational needs. The team will obviously be warned of the changes in time.

**Every player must take note of the rules of the game with the exceptions above.**
